

**TATAMY BOROUGH COUNCIL EMERGENCY MEETING MINUTES  
TUESDAY MARCH 24, 2020 AT 5:00 P.M.**

An emergency meeting of the Tatamy Borough Council was held on Tuesday, March 24, 2020 via teleconference. The meeting was called to order at 5:08 p.m. by Council Vice President Pamela Pearson.

**ROLL CALL**

The following Council members were present at the meeting: Daniel Dewey, Robert Hayes, Pamela Pearson, Kristine Porter, Robert Wagner, and Frank Young. Also present were, Christopher Moren, Mayor, Donald DeReamus, EMO Coordinator, Keith Snyder, Police Chief, and Deanne Werkheiser, Secretary/ Treasurer. Joseph Rago was absent.

The emergency meeting was called to adopt Resolution 2020-01 that extends Tatamy Borough's State of Emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic and Resolution 2020-02 authorizing a Memorandum of Understanding for the Police Department during the State of Emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Both resolutions were emailed earlier to Council members for review.

- 1 A motion was made by Daniel Dewey, seconded by Kristine Porter to approve Resolution 2020-01, extending Tatamy Borough's State of Emergency. Motion approved unanimously.
- 2 Keith Snyder explained the MOU. If officers would be quarantined due to COVID-19, this would allow officers from the two other departments to cover calls within Tatamy Borough. The resolution has been reviewed by our solicitor David Jordan. A motion was made by Frank Young, seconded by Robert Wagner to approve Resolution 2020-02, Tatamy Police MOU. Motion approved unanimously.
- 3 Signers will come to office at differing times to sign the resolution.

A motion was made by Daniel Dewey, seconded by Kristine Porter to adjourn the emergency meeting at 5:14 pm. Motion approved unanimously.
